Re: 2022 Water Main Replacement Program

Dear Resident,

This letter is to inform you that the City of Huber Heights is starting another year of our Water Main Replacement Program and your street will be part of this year's program. The City has been tracking water main breaks throughout the City and we know that there have been numerous breaks in your area, and we would like to replace these water mains as soon as possible. Included is a map that shows the area of the City that five portions of streets will have the existing 6" cast iron water main replaced with a new 8" ductile iron main. The streets affected are:

Cruxten Drive from Chesham Drive to Tilbury Road
Hubbard Drive from Morley Lane to Hemmingway Road
Alter Road from Hubbard Drive to Menlo Way
Holbrook Drive from Harshmanville Road to Helwig Drive
Helwig Drive from Holbrook Drive to Alter Road

Your property is located within one of these replacement areas. A second map attached shows a close-up aerial picture of the street in front of your house that shows the location of the new water main (blue line) that will be installed. The contractor will be M&T Excavating and they plan to start the replacement on one of these roads possibly in December or at the beginning of 2023 (weather dependent). We do not know the exact order of the construction, but they plan to work on one street at a time. As they complete each street, they will move on to one of the other streets. During construction on each street, the street will be closed to thru traffic, but will be open for local traffic (residents) to get to their driveways. The water service to your house will remain active throughout the construction, except for a few hours at the end when your service line is switched over to the new water main, the contractor will let you know when that will occur.

If you have any questions about the water main installation, you can call the City at (937) 233-1423 and ask to speak to the Engineering Department. We also plan to hold a Town Hall Meeting concerning this project on Tuesday, December 13, 2022, at the Huber Heights Senior Center located at 6428 Chambersburg Road. The meeting is scheduled from 6:00 to 7:00 pm. The City Engineering staff will be there to discuss the project and to answer any questions. You can also contact me by email at:
